Independent Examiner's Report to the members of St. John the Evangelist, Lacey Green, Parochial Church Council.

I report on the accounts for the year ended 31 December 2021 which are set out on pages 4 to 9.

Respective responsibilities of the Trustees and Independent Examiner As trustees of the charity, the members of the PCC are responsible for the preparation of the accounts.
